### Canlyniadau TGAU a Safon Uwch Haf 2023

Braf iawn oedd dathlu canlyniadau da iawn eleni eto yn Llanhari, wrth i gynifer o ddisgyblion blwyddyn 13 gyrraedd eu potensial a chael eu haediant ar ôl gweithio'n galed yn ystod eu cyfnod yn y chweched dosbarth gan llwyddo yn wyneb heriau ôl-Covid. Roedd 71% o'r holl raddau a enillwyd gan y disgylion yn raddau A\*-C ac rydym yn falch bod 97% o'r disgylion wedi llwyddo i ennill

graddau A\*-E mewn tri neu fwy o bynciau Safon Uwch. Llwyddodd pob disgylb a wnaeth gais, i gael lle i astudio mewn prifysgol.

Roedd y canlyniadau TGAU eleni yn ardderchog a rydym mor falch bod cynifer o ddisyblion wedi dychwelyd i'r chweched dosbarth yn Llanhari. Dyma'r criw mwyaf i ddychwelyd i'r chweched dosbarth ers nifer fawr o flynyddoedd ac rydym yn edrych ymlaen at eu gweld yn ffynnu ac yn arwain y disgylbion iau. Testun balchder arbennig yw'r ffaith bod 26.5% o'r disgylbion wedi llwyddo i ennill 5 neu fwy o raddau A\*-A ac uchafbwynt arall yw'r ffaith bod 72.5% o'r disgylbion wedi ennill graddau A\*-C mewn pum neu fwy o bynciau gan gynnwys Mathemateg a Chymraeg neu Saesneg. Enillodd 87% o'r disgylbion raddau A\*-C mewn pum neu fwy o bynciau ac o'r nifer yma enillodd 70% o'r disgylbion o leiaf deg gradd TGAU A\*-C. ardderchog lle llwyddodd disgylbion ar draws yr ystod gallu i gyrraedd eu nodau personol, gan amlygu ymroddiad arbennig i'w hastudiaethau

### Adeilad yr ysgol



I would like to remind the secondary department parents to contact reception rather than calling / texting your child during the day. We expect the pupils to keep their phones switched off at the bottom of the bag and only use them under the guidance of a teacher.

## High standards

At the beginning of the term all the pupils were reminded of our values and expectations in terms of positive behaviour, Welshness, respect, attendance, effort and perseverance when completing work. We kindly ask for your support with these matters and specifically in ensuring a high standard in terms of the school uniform. The expectations are clearly stated for the secondary pupils in the school prospectus and have been communicated to you as parents on numerous occasions.

## GCSE and A Level results Summer 2023

We were again able to celebrate a very good set of A Level results this year. We are delighted that 71% of all grades achieved were A\*- C grades, with 97% of the pupils attaining three or more A levels at grades A\*-E. We are very pleased that all pupils have achieved their potential and that their hard work has been rewarded despite the challenges faced post-Covid. All pupils who applied to university were successful in their applications.

Our GCSE results were excellent too and I am delighted that so many pupils have returned to the sixth form. This is the largest cohort for many years and we look forward to seeing them flourish in school and develop into young leaders. Most notably, 26.5% of the cohort achieved A\*-A grades in at least five or more subjects and another highlight is the fact that 72.5% of the pupils achieved at least five A\*-C grades including Maths and either Welsh or English. In all, 87% of the cohort achieved 5 A\*-C grades and of these, 70% of the pupils attained at least 10 GCSE qualifications at A\*-C grades. The school is very proud of all the year 11 pupils as this set of excellent examination results saw pupils across the ability range achieving their goals, reflecting their dedication to their studies.

Thank you very much to you as parents for your constant support for your children and for your willingness to work with the teachers.

### **Attendance**

Pupils' attendance at Llanhari is very good and last year our attendance percentage was amongst the best in Rhondda Cynon Taf. At the start of the year, I would like to remind you that the school's target for attendance is 95%. You are kindly asked not to organise holidays during the season where possible and if necessary, the request should not be made more than three months in advance. We will not authorise holidays if your child's attendance is below 95% in the last twelve months.

Following the recent news about RAAC, Rhondda Cynon Taf has asked me to inform you that the county's school buildings are safe. More details can be found in this statement


