Gwisg ysgol

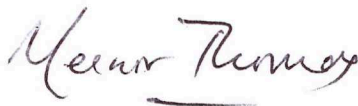

Filming a television series "Athrawon" in September

I would like to note one specific thing about next year in Llanhari. A Welsh TV company Carlam will be filming a series for S4C at the school between September 2025 and July 2026. The aim of the series is to follow some newly qualified teachers as they take their first steps in their chosen career, and to see the many different aspects of their work- such as helping with extracurricular activities and visits, teaching their specific subjects and working with their registration classes. Three new teachers will join us in September namely Mr Siôn-Rhys Evans (Science and Chemistry) Mr Cao Pryce (Welsh) and Miss Rianna Sutton (Design Technology and Catering)

The filming will take place on specific days every half term, but this will not disrupt the pupils' education in any way. The main focus of the filming will be the teachers themselves and not the pupils but some will be featured in the process.

This series is aimed at family audience in a primetime, pre-watershed slot and with accompanying content on some social media platforms.

I will contact you as parents with more details in September but it is likely that the film company will be filming the teachers on the pupils' first day on September 3rd. School uniform

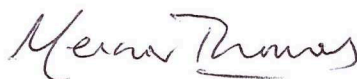
