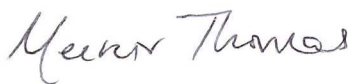

Using the app will provide parents and carers with a quick and convenient way to notify the school when their child is absent.

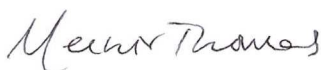
