Rydym hefyd yn falch iawn o lwyddiannau ein disgyblion Blwyddyn 11 a Blwyddyn 13 yn eu harholiadau diweddar. Mae'r canlyniadau'n adlewyrchu eu gwaith caled, eu dyfalbarhad a'u hymrwymiad dros gyfnod hir. Mae llawer wedi cyflawni canlyniadau rhagorol, ac mae nifer wedi rhagori ar eu targedau personol. Mae bron pob un o'r disgyblion Safon Uwch wedi cyrraedd neu ragori ar eu potensial gyda 91% o'r disgyblion yn ennill 3 gradd neu fwy ar A*-E, ac mae nifer o ganlyniadau nodedig gan unigolion sy'n haeddu canmoliaeth arbennig. Y merched oedd yn arwain y ffordd eleni gyda Caitlin Rees, Ffion Reid, Mali Jenkins a Lili Fiest yn llwyddo i ennill o leiaf 3 A*-A gradd. Rydym yn hynod falch o ddisgyblion Blwyddyn 13, nid yn unig am eu llwyddiannau academiaidd yn arholiadau Haf 2026, ond hefyd am eu cyfraniad eang i fywyd yr ysgol tra roeddent yn ddisgyblion yn Llanhari.

Mae mwy o ddisgyblion na'r arfer wedi dychwelyd i flwyddyn 12 yn dilyn llwyddiant nodedig yn yr arholiadau TGAU. Testun balchder arbennig yw'r ffaith bod 100% o'r disgyblion wedi llwyddo i ennill 5 neu fwy o raddau A*-G ac o'r rheiny mae 82% wedi llwyddo i ennill 5 neu fwy o raddau A*-C, gyda 23% o'r garfan yn ennill 5 neu fwy o raddau A*-A. Llwyddodd disgyblion ar draws yr ystod gallu i gyrraedd eu nodau personol.

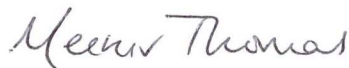

I would like to extend a very warm welcome to our pupils as they return to school at the start of the new term and welcome 100 pupils to year seven along with new pupils to Dewi Draenog, our nursery class. It has been a pleasure to see them settling quickly and positively into their routines, and staff have been delighted with their attitude and enthusiasm.

High Expectations

During the first week, we have emphasised our clear expectations in respect of high standards in all aspects of school life. We have also revisited the importance of our three core values—Community, Welshness and Progress—which underpin our school culture and guide our pupils to be responsible, respectful and ambitious members of our community.

Congratulations!

We are also extremely proud of the achievements of our Year 11 and Year 13 pupils in their recent examinations. Their results reflect their hard work, perseverance and commitment over a long period. Many achieved excellent outcomes, with a number surpassing their personal targets. Almost every learner has reached, and in many cases exceeded, their potential, with 91% of the pupils attaining at least 3 or more grades at A*-E. There are a number of exceptional individual achievements which deserve special recognition. The girls are leading the way this year with Caitlin Rees, Ffion Reid, Mali Jenkins and Lili Fiest attaining at least 3 A*-A grades. We are immensely proud of our Year 13 students—not only for their academic success, but also for the contribution they have made to the school during their time here.

An increased number of pupils have returned to year 12 following their excellent GCSE success. Most notably, 100% of the cohort achieved A*-G grades in at least five or more subjects, and of those, 82% of the pupils achieved an A*-C grade in five or more subjects with 23% of the cohort achieving 5 or more A*-A grades. The school is very proud of all year 11 pupils as this set of excellent examination results saw pupils across the ability range achieving their goals.

- 23 September Parents' meeting for the Normandy Trip October 2026

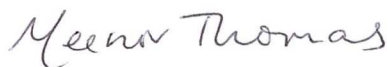
